The UK Covid-19 Inquiry

The UK Covid-19 Inquiry will commence Public Hearings for its seventh investigation on **Monday 12th May 2025**.



This module will look at, and make recommendations on, the approach to testing, tracing and isolation adopted during the pandemic.

The module will also consider the policies and strategies developed and deployed to support the test, trace and isolate system by the UK Government and the Devolved Administrations.

It will consider the decisions made by key bodies, other options or technologies that were available and factors that may have influenced public compliance.

Please note that Module 6 of the UK Covid-19 Inquiry will take place after Module 7 and will begin on June 30th 2025.
